

An Unroll of the Dice



Since time immemorial dice have been cubes and nothing more. But, today, in 2024, we can report the introduction of a truly innovative gaming technology - the unrolled dice!

Unrolled dice are printed, cut, and even stored flat. When you fold them up to roll, they snap together with magnets and **opposing sides add to 7**, just like any other dice.

But, when the game is done, just unroll and slide the dice back into their 6x6 case - with all three in place, you should be able to fill each row, column, and 3x2 box with the digits 1-6 without repeats.

The manufacturer, DDice, plans a full production run by the end of the year; so, be sure to preorder a set. With dice like these you won't need more than a little **blind luck** to **beat the odds!**
